## Genesis 4

### Introduction

6.a) How can we bring an acceptable offering to God? (See Ps. 51:15-17)

b) What is more important, the form of worship or the attitude of the worshipers?

7.a) What is society like in this chapter (vv.17-24)?

b) Is our society like this today?

c) In what ways?

8.a) Is there any hope in this chapter (vv.25-26)?

b) How can we make a difference in our society today?
